

PRESS RELEASE 25[™] MAY 2012: Contract to deliver Prison Visitors' Services in the North-West

POPS (Partners of Prisoners and Families Support Group) is delighted to announce that the Ministry of Justice has awarded POPS the contract to provide Prison Visitors' Services in 9 prisons across the North-West.

Our model of service delivery, 'Making the Connection', aims to ensure visitors, and prisoners, are able to connect with a spectrum of services, both within the prison environment and in their local community. Underpinning this is service user engagement which will continue to inform and influence the design and delivery of the work. POPS social enterprise, 2nd Chance, is a significant part of this picture, supporting rehabilitation and resettlement through the provision of work placements for prisoners on release in the community. Our approach recognises the family as a key contributor in the offender journey and takes into account the specific and diverse needs of 'troubled families' and the importance of timely and effective interventions to improve outcomes for prisoners and their families.

Our commitment to the equalities agenda and service user engagement will continue to inform and influence our service delivery.
